6. Matters arising not elsewhere on the agenda

Ex officio on PCC Simon Belcher, Mary Poole, David Ratnum, Craig Tranfield and Pat Watson are not automatically elected tp PC. PC happy to co-opt them. David Burch is also ex-officio PCC, but does not wish to serve on PC.

7. Appointment of Officers

Chair: Revd Dick Gray to continue.

Treasurer: Sue Green formally appointed

8 Ministry

Appointment of Tricia Roberts as non-stipendiary minister in the partnership.

The PC were happy to approve the appointment and recognise the gifts that Tricia brings to the team, but concerns were raised about denominational imbalance Letters had been written by HTS and TH, and others expressed their concerns verbally. There were also concerns raised about availability of ministers visiting other churches in the partnership and whether this appointment would ease the situation. In its present form it will probably not have much impact. The PC recognised the Robert's family responsibilities, but would like to also consider if there is any leeway for Tudor to have a wider involvement. **DG to follow up with Diocese.**

An absence of **Methodist Lay ministry** was noted.

To help with the imbalance of Anglican / non conformist on the staff team, it was decided to **consider appointing Mike Dilly**, but there are many questions to be asked including financial implications. **DG to progress.**

Di Benbow Emeritus status

Permission to officiate as licence due for renewal. **PC happy to continue**.

Review of Anne Carter

Anne's 5 year licence appointment expires in 18 months. Anne would like to extend her period and would like it to be open-ended. At present this is not so due to denomination needs for rotation.

There will be a performance review which could begin before Anne goes on Sabbatical. **DG** to set up process.

Ministers away 24 Hours.

Graham Sparks led ministers on an excellent day recently. The team are enthusiastic to repeat quality time together, seeking funding to go to Nympsfield overnight. PC agreed.

Intercessions

Ideas are needed to make more intentional links between churches through intercessions. Need a lay person to take it on and lead it.

9 Finance

Ticking along as expected, looking good at the moment.

Greenbelt put £2,000 into Mix festival.

Still anticipating having to use £10,000 of reserve.

Baptist Union GB Pension issue; Due to a large deficit in BU pension fund, there will likely be a need to keep paying pension funds to them for some time after the end of Anne's Ministry. Sue reminded us though, that things will improve financially generally in the country, and so we don't anticipate this will be a problem.

HMRC has increased the mileage expenses from 40p to 45p per mile. Discussion also revealed that this rate is payable for all journeys up to 10,000 miles per year (25 p per mile over 10,000). Previously staff had understood that journeys over 30 miles should be calculated at a lower rate. PC approved relying on their guidelines. Takes effect from 6th April 2011.

HTS would like to pay their cleaner via the Partnership payroll; PC approved Thrive (youth confirmation class) support will cost £30 per week; PC approved.

Messy church getting more attendance from a wider age range..

Mix festival coming along well.

Emerge and Careforce worker; Doreen leaving in August. Will be joint service 31 July at St Mary's and BBQ/picnic to say farewell at that time. Also songs of praise in the walled garden. Doreen's replacement is likely to be Imogen Kershaw.

Buildings work; St Mary's roof repair progress is very slow due to it being a listed building. The HTS new door is now successfully installed.

All Saints still looking into multimedia system, new toilets and comfortable pews.

Development of lay people not covered as Clive was away.
